Divine Health and Immortality

The wages of sin are sickness and death. (Romans 6:23 & John 5:1-14 with emphasis on verse 14). The deuterocanonical book (The Wisdom of Solomon), which was removed from the Christian Bible, states the following in Chapter 3, from verse 1 to 9: "But righteous people are protected by God and will never suffer torment. It is a foolish mistake to think that righteous people die and that their death is a terrible evil. They leave us but it is not a disaster. In fact, the righteous are at peace. It might appear that they have suffered punishment, but they have a confident hope of immortality. Their sufferings were light compared with the blessings they will receive. God has tested them, like gold in a furnace, and found them worthy to be with Him. He has accepted them, just as He accepts the sacrifices which His worshippers burn on the altar. When God comes to reward the righteous, they will blaze out against the wicked, like fire in dry straw. They will rule over nations and peoples and the Lord will be their king for ever. Those who have put their trust in God will come to understand the truth of His ways. Those who have been faithful will live with him in his love, for he is kind and merciful to the ones whom he has chosen."

In Old Testament times it was thought that God wanted animal sacrifices that were burnt and offered to Him on the altar. Blood had to flow to take away the sins of the people. With the coming of Jesus Christ of Nazareth and His death and resurrection, a new doctrine was formed. This doctrine teaches that Jesus' blood flowed to buy forgiveness for the sins of the multitudes. For the perverse generations since the death and resurrection of Jesus, until 2012 AD, this doctrine worked well. People all over the world embraced this new religion, for now they no longer have to slaughter animals, as Jesus' blood flowed for all. It is done because of our LOVE for God and all of creation. It is not about giving food to the lazy; it is about educating and encouraging them. It is about helping the lost and the lazy to help themselves.

The only way to save this world from self-destruction, is to teach all people about the way of Christ. Every child in this world should attend a school and every child should be issued with a free New Testament Christian Bible in the language of their choice. Every household in the world should have access to a New Testament Christian Bible. Governments should stop giving people what they want and start giving them what they need. - 3. Or we can serve the "devil", live in sin, and face eternal damnation.


